The Ledge: House Rules

- The Ledge: pool hours are Tuesdays - Sundays 5:30AM to 10:30PM, Mondays 11AM - 10:30PM.
- Only Veramendi residents and their guests may use the pool and gated areas at The Ledge, and they do so at their own risk.
- Veramendi Residential Master Community assumes no responsibility for accidents or injury.
- Residents are responsible for supervising the young children in company.
- Do not prop gates open and please call us if any are not working properly.
- Bathing suits are the required attire, including infants, for swimming.
- Kids under 12 are only allowed with a parent or guardian supervising.
- No glassware or breakable containers are allowed. At all. Ever.
- No eating, drinking or gum chewing while in the pool.
- Please do not run, rough house, or make loud disruptive noise.
- Users are responsible for any items lost, damaged, or stolen.
- Safety equipment is only to be used in a case of emergency.
- Residents are responsible for any additional costs associated with cleanup, repairs, or damages to The Ledge.
- Residents may bring up to 5 guests per household at a time.
- Swim diapers only; no ordinary diapers are allowed in the pool. Changing diapers within 6 feet of the pool is prohibited.
- Do not bring any animals into the pool area. Registered working dogs are welcome in the pool area, but not in the pool.
- Evacuate the pool during lightning storms or any type of contamination.
- No smoking, illegal drugs, firearms or fireworks anywhere within the pool area.
- Any person with open wounds not allowed in the pool.
- Do not swim if you have been ill with diarrhea within the past two weeks.
- Do not jump or climb fences as you will be subject to criminal prosecution and suspended for future visits.
- No bicycles, motorbikes, scooters, skateboards, etc. within the gates of the pool area.
- Residents and their guests are subject to losing visitation privileges if the house rules are not followed.
